Official Hazard Communication Protocols Required of all Students


Student Attire

- Proper attire is required for your safety at all times.
- You should wear clothes – including closed-toed footwear - that protect your skin from contact with any of the materials used during the lab exercise.
- Your lab materials will instruct you if extra attire – goggles or gloves – are to be worn during the lab exercise.



Lab Space

- Designate a space where you will be performing the lab exercises. Remove any material that does not pertain to the exercise. Clean the area before and after the exercise. No eating or drinking while working in the lab area.



Emergency Safety

- Be aware of any emergency safety equipment that you may have in your lab area, such as a fire extinguisher.
 - Learn how to properly use each piece of equipment.
- Be aware of the best route to take if you need to exit the lab area rapidly during an emergency.



Biohazard and Disposal Protocols

- Read the instructions that come with any lab materials that you receive:
 - Know the proper way to store the materials.
 - Know the proper way to dispose of the materials at the end of the course.

 - Keep your safety equipment on at all times?
 - Not bring food into the lab?
 - Clean up your workspace before leaving the lab
